

Estimated Costs for Exchange Students at Ivey

Costs in Canada are relevant to the country from which you are coming. Therefore, you alone can determine whether Canada is expensive or inexpensive. A chart of estimated costs is below. Do not assume you can live on less than this chart suggests. It is better to overestimate than underestimate.
